

Temporary Road Closures on S.C. 6 and Old Bush River Road.doc

Motorists should be prepared for temporary road closures on S.C. 6 and Old Bush River Road between 7:30 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. on Saturday, September 10 during the 25th annual 10-K Dam Run near Irmo.

Lexington County Sheriff James R. Metts said all travel lanes on S.C. 6 at the Dreher Shoals Dam on Lake Murray will be closed to traffic between 7:30 a.m. and 8 a.m. on Saturday. All travel lanes on Old Bush River Road between the Dreher Shoals Dam and Saluda Shoals Park will be closed to traffic between 7:30 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. on Saturday.

The 10-K Dam Run will begin on the Lexington side of the Dreher Shoals Dam near the intersection of S.C. 6 and Corley Mill Road, Metts said. The Dam Run will end at Saluda Shoals Park off Old Bush River Road.

The Lexington County Sheriff's Department Traffic Division will coordinate traffic control checkpoints during the 10-K Dam Run, Metts said. Sheriff's Department deputies, reserve deputies and South Carolina Highway Patrol troopers will man the traffic control checkpoints.

The St. Andrews Rotary Club, Irmo Chapin Recreation Commission and Interact Club are sponsoring the 10-K Dam Run.
